Condition noted at time of original cataloging in 1980: "Has three repaired cracks, shows re-cracking; needs attention; inside is dirty." \_\_\_\_\_ Orient with longest tear starting at 12 o'clock. Selvage: Tear in wall starting at 12 o'clock, creating 1cm wide gap. 2cm of off-white accretion starting at 12 o'clock and moving clockwise. 1/2cm loss starting 2cm from 12 o'clock. 1cm of off white accretion 1cm counterclockwise from 2 o'clock. Tear in wall starting at 2 o'clock, creating 1cm wide gap. 1cm loss, 3cm counterclockwise from 3 o'clock. 7cm loss starting 2cm clockwise from 4 o'clock. 1/2 loss between 6 o'clock and 7 o'clock. 1/2cm loss at 7 o'clock. Tear in wall starting 1cm counterclockwise from 8 o'clock, creating 1/2cm wide gap with fraying. 1/2cm loss at 10 o'clock. 4.5cm loss starting 2 cm from 10 o'clock. 1cm of off white accretion on the left edge of 12 o'clock tear. Interior: Bottom darkened and discolored, starting from center and extending 11cm in diameter. Several areas of discoloration, possibly accretion, in the bottom; just above 3 o'clock, 10cm from the center; at 4 o'clock, 4cm from the center, at 5 o'clock starting 7cm from the center and extending 2.5 cm; 3 areas between 6 o'clock and 7 o'clock, 1mm each, starting 5cm from center; at 8 o'clock 3cm from center; 1cm counterclockwise from 9 o'clock, 5cm from center. Large tear starting at 12 o'clock in selvage, 1cm wide, continuing 11cm down basket wall. Evidence of past repair on tear, with stitching across tear, mostly torn. Last 4cm of tear has intact stitching. Tear starting at 2 o'clock in selvage, 1cm wide, continuing 8cm down basket wall. Evidence of past repair on tear, with stitching across tear, mostly torn. Last 2.5cm has intact stitching. Tear starting 1cm counterclockwise from 8 o'clock in selvage, 1/2cm wide, continuing 4cm down basket wall. Evidence of past repair on tear, with stitching across tear, mostly intact. Top 1.5cm of tear frayed, stitching torn. Off white accretion in stitching in top of tear. Exterior: Minor abrasion to the weft throughout, causing minor discoloration. Tears noted in interior visible on exterior, but the stitching noted above is not visible on the exterior, except through the tear itself. Several small areas of a dark discoloration, possibly accretion, on the weft throughout. Only warp visible in weight bearing area of base. Old catalog sticker labeled "42" stuck to center of bottom.
